SAFETY PROCEDURES

Our top priority is to keep everyone as safe as possible while still allowing you the opportunity to enjoy the arts. Please review our safety guidelines as we begin to re-open to the public.

GENERAL PROCEDURES

- *Increased cleaning staff to provide frequent cleaning and to disinfect high touch/high traffic areas.*
- *Everyone is required to sanitize their hands as they enter the building. Hand sanitizer stations have been added throughout the facility for your convenience. Frequent hand washing is also encouraged.*
- *Staff, patrons, volunteers and students will be required to wear masks at all times while inside the facility.*
- *Temperature checks will be required to enter the facility. Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed into the facility.*
- *Registration for classes and show ticket purchases are available online or by calling the Box Office only. The Box Office will only accept walk up ticket sales one hour prior to the performance.*
- *If you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, please stay home. We will gladly work with you to exchange your show tickets or provide you a credit towards any programming at Osceola Arts.*

THEATER PRODUCTIONS/ART EXHIBITS

- *Plexiglass has been installed at the Box Office window.*
- *E-tickets area available when buying your tickets and can be viewed from your mobile device. You do not need to print your tickets at home.*
- *The seating capacity of the theater has been reduced to adhere to social distancing guidelines.*
- *Concessions will not be available. Outside food or drink will not be allowed.*
- *New load in/load out procedures will be followed to minimize interaction between parties. Detailed information will be emailed to all event attendees 24 hours prior to their scheduled showtime.*
- *Show programs will now be available in digital format limit to contact with materials.*

CLASSES/REHEARSALS

- *Class size will be reduced to follow social distancing recommendations.*
- *Anyone with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be accepted for class that day and must remain home for 24 hours after they are no longer symptomatic.*
- *Only staff & students will be allowed in the building. All students under 18 should be dropped off & picked up in the main parking lot.*
- *Classroom materials will be wiped clean after each class and the use of shared materials will be limited or eliminated completely*
